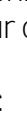

-H Project Achievement competition! Now is the time to check out the project listing and choose a subject in which you are interested. Project Achievement takes place on Saturday, February 8, 2020 at Clarke Middle School from 9:30 AM until NOON.

To participate in this competition students present a 3-6 minute informative speech about their topic, using visuals such as posters or items to enhance their presentation. Unfortunately in this 4-H competition we cannot use PowerPoint or similar computer generated programs for these presentations. There are a few exceptions to the speech requirement that were outlined on your project list sheet. Students interested in the Between Meal Snacks or Food Fare category must make an appointment with 4-H staff to learn about the special requirements for those projects. You and a parent will need to meet with 4-H staff before competing in either.

Students compete against other students who are presenting in the same category they have selected. Judges will listen to each presentation and award points in the following manner: *appearance, visual aids, delivery, orderly progress, accuracy of information, coverage of subject, knowledge of subject and time limit.* As a bonus, winners from the CPA competition in February will earn the opportunity to travel to Jackson County to compete in the District contest on March 21st.
