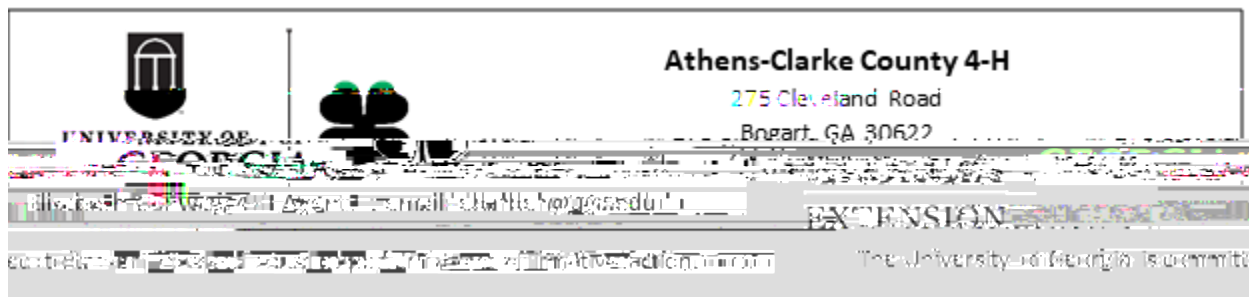
Please contact Ms. Conway if you need instructions for Video Platforms for Generating Links or you may e-mail video to Teacher or to Ms. Conway.
