### 4-H Programs that count as 2 Activities

- x Project Achievement (4-H's Public Speaking Program)
  - o Cloverleaf: compete in Tifton on November 19, 2022
  - o Jr/Sr: portfolios due by December 21, 2022; competition at Rock Eagle February 10-12, 2023.
  - o State 4-H Congress - state level competition for senior project achievement district winners held in July in Atlanta.
- x Summer Camps
  - o Cloverleaf Camp @ Wahsega 4-H Center: June 13 - 17, 2022
  - o Junior Camp @ Jekyll Island 4-H Center: July 4 - 8, 2022
  - o Senior Event @ Rock Eagle 4-H Center: July 4 - 8, 2022
- x Leadership Conferences
  - o State 4-H Senior Event for 8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> @ Rock Eagle 4-H Center: June 24 - 26, 2022
  - o Jr. Fall Conference for 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders @ Rock Eagle 4-H Center, November 10-11, 2022
  - o Sr. Fall Forum for 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders @ Rock Eagle 4-H Center, December 10-11, 2022
- x Judging Programs – you must attend the majority of the practices & the respective state contest.
  - o Livestock Judging Team - Deron coaches this program, practices start in November/December each year and run through March. The State Contest is March 18, 2023.
  - o Horse Quiz Bowl - This program is coached by our Horse Club volunteer, Emily Andrews. Practices begin

- x Food Nutrition Contest for Cloverleaf age 4-H'ers only (4<sup>th</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> graders)
  - o Peanut Recipe Contest - held every year in November/December, 4-H'ers prepare a creative, healthy peanut butter recipe.
  - o MilkMake Contest - held each year in December, 4-H'ers create & prepare their own milkshake recipe.
  
- x "Summer Fun" Program (for Cloverleaf age 4-H'ers only) - this program offers various activities (trips, tours, workshops) for 4-H'ers during the summer months. The program schedule is usually set & advertised during May.
  
- x Horticulture Growing Contest – Cloverleaf age 4-H'er only
  - o Giant Watermelon Growing Contest - plant seeds early inside and transplant around Easter, must be weighed for State Contest by August 1<sup>st</sup>. Visit the following website for more information <http://www.georgia4h.org/watermeloncontest/>
  - o Giant Pumpkin Growing Contest - plant seeds early inside and transplant after last spring frost. Pumpkins must be weighed for State Contest by October 1<sup>st</sup>. Visit the following website for more information <http://www.georgia4h.org/pumpkincontest/default.htm>
