## What to expect when choosing to participate in JR/SR DPA!!!!

## Junior Objectives:

To acquire an understanding of subject matter in a given project area.

To develop skills in researchingssembling and presenting information.

To stimulate interest in continuing project work through 4-H experiences.

To provide opportunities for 4-H members to operated enhance qualities often; sportsmanship, cooperation, poise and self-confidence.

To help 4-H members develop skills in leadership and communication.

**Purpose:** To give recognition for outstanding accomplishments in 4-H work. 4-H'ers who summit a portfolio will compete with other countiesheir district for district honors.

## **Eligibility Rules**

Must be a 4-H member in good standing.

Junior 4-H members and parents must sign a JR/SR DPA Participation Contract.

No award will be made unless a 4-H membertsomplishments are supported by records required (portfolio). If records are not submitted byddeted-H members are not eligible to compete.
4-H'ers who have been district first place winnepstorpeat as a Junior 4-H member are not eligible to participate in the same project again as a Junior 4-H bene For example, a 4-H'er placing first in the Dog Care (7th grade) Project is ineligifor the Dog Care (8th grade) project.

## Project Procedure:

- 1. Enroll in and carry out activities in project selected.
- 2. Submit a portfolio with project and 4-H activities eted following the portfolio format.

Rough Draft must be turned in no later than that Yor November 7, 2017
Final Draft is due no later than Jan. 2, 2018

- 3. Once you have submitted the portfolio & point sheet you are signed up for District Project Achievement.
- 3. Plan, prepare and give demonstrationil wastrated talk on some phase of a project.

**Illustrated Talk** - A presentation using posters or other props (Showing steps in preparatiomist required and not appropriate.)

**Lab** - A specified product must be prepared during a scheduled lab period. (See specific project guidelines for requirements at www.georgia4h.org) No formal presentation is required; however, 4-H'er must be able to answer questions abouts, nutrition and the project during discussion with the judges.

- 4. Participate at District Projechievement and give a presentation on any phase of project selected. (March 2-4, 2018)
- 5. Seventh Graders may choose to run for North West Junior (California) more information 770-288-8421)
