



Childcare Provider Training May 5, 2020

The UGA Extension -Tattnall/Ware Counties are holding a 2-hour training on May 5, 2020. This class will be taught via Zoom an online program. *Each class will provide two (2) Hours of state-accepted child care training for child care providers.*

The class will be taught by Rachel Stewart, Family and Consumer Sciences Agent in Tattnall County and Carrie Vanderver, Family and Consumer Sciences Agent in Ware County.

In this course, child care providers will learn to recognize potential dangers in the environment and learn steps to take to reduce the risk of SIDS. They will also learn to define possible choking hazards for infants & children, and how to pinpoint and resolve possible health & safety issues in their home or center. Participants will learn about the importance of developing an emergency plan for their center or home daycare, and they will receive the skills and tools needed to implement one. Training will include playground safety and car seat safety.
